

BACKGROUND

The school took off with pioneer students of 13 boys and 15 girls in September 2014 and the number increased to 30 students at the end of the first session.

The school was established by the then Provincial Pastor of Ondo Province 2, Pastor Ayo Ajisola. The school started at her temporary site the Redeemed Christian Church of God, Faith Sanctuary, located at Ademulegun road, opposite Akiavic Hotels, Ondo.

As a mission school, the school has continued to impact on her students positively on matters relating to having God-fearing relationship through spiritual exercises ranging from singing, sincere worship, Bible teaching etc.

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ADMISSION POLICY

The school is international and therefore admits students of ages 10 and above from every nation, race, colour, class and culture through an entrance examination followed by interview session. Merit is our watchword as it is placed above all other considerations.

THE SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The school operates in line with the subjects offered in the national curriculum in accordance with the National Policy on Education.

AFFORDABLE EDUCATION

As a school, we believe that education should be both accessible and affordable: this we ensure by making studying with us affordable as possible.

LEARNING MATERIALS

Text books are to be purchased by the students. A list of recommended books is attached to the students' bill every session. However, the school provides customized exercise books with the school logo. Students must bring their writing materials: pen, pencils, rulers, erasers etc.

THE SCHOOL CALENDAR

The school operates an academic session in accordance with the state government calendar/RCCG mission calendar. The session begins from September and ends in July. It is classified as follows:

September to December (first term), January to April (second term) and April to July (third term)

MEDICAL FACILITIES

On admission, each student is required to submit a certificate of fitness from a government hospital.

All cases of ill-health must be reported immediately to the health officer in the school.

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RELIGION

The lordship of Jesus Christ forms the bedrock of all our religious activities and practices. The supremacy of the Bible is upheld above all things through the help of the Holy spirit. This, however, is not an obstacle to academic excellence but rather an enhancing factor.

GAMES AND SPORTS

Physical and Health Education is taught in the school. It is compulsory for all student to take part in sports. The school has the stuff to teach and coach students in all sports and games. The school organizes and prepares students for both inter-house sports competition and external competitions.

SCHOOL FEES

_All fees are to be paid directly to the bank and must be paid on or before the first week of every term.

STUDENTS' IDENTITY CARDS

Every student is expected to have one identity card obtainable in the school. This will be used by the students in the school for identification and security purposes.

PARENT- TEACHER FORUM

A viable parent-teacher forum exists in the school. This body meets at least once a term. Other meetings could be scheduled to discuss very urgent matters at times. This body partners the school financially to finance PTF projects

USE OF SCHOOL PROPERTIES

Students should handle the school properties with utmost care and caution. Any damage to any school property must be reported immediately. Offenders will make replacements

MUTUAL RESPECT

All junior students should obey their seniors so far it is in accordance with the school rules and also seniors should not bully their juniors. Punishment will be rolled out to the offenders.

DEVELOPMENTAL DISCIPLINE

INTRODUCTION:

The school's approach towards discipline is for every student to acquire self-discipline and be responsible so as to contribute to the overall well-being of all in the school.

Every child has the right to expect a conducive teaching and learning environment likewise every student has the responsibility to contribute to that environment.

All CRSSO students are expected to fulfill these 3 basic expectations

- Respect people and property- students are to be respectful in attitude and manner to people and property
- ii. Attend school regularly students are to attend all academic programmes co-curricular activities, school functions and other school related programmes.
- iii.Do and submit work- students are to work diligently not only on assigned daily class work, homework, project and others but also have regular self-revision in order to ensure quality work is produced.

Note: Parents are to help the school ensure these expectations are met.

RULES AND REGULATION

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Attendance in school is compulsory. Absence from school must be made known to the school management from the parents or guardians. Excuse from school may be granted on health and compassionate grounds. All letters of excuse or permission of absence must be submitted to the class teacher on or before the student returns to school.

Absence without valid reason will be deemed as truancy which will be met with stern punishment.

Parents need to apply for leave of absence for their child from the vice principal to leave or absent themselves from school for urgent private matters. Permission to leave school early may be granted for special cases. The class teacher must be informed by the students and permission must be obtained from the principal or vice principal.

His/her parent/guardian will be contacted but his or her name will be entered in the Early Dismissal book in the general office.

Students must be punctual for school, co- curricular activities and all school events. Students who are late for school i.e after morning assembly are subjected to late coming procedures before they are allowed back to class. Parents are not allowed to plead in this case.

DAILY ASSEMBLY

- Students are expected to be in school on or before 7:30am
- All students must stand at attention for the recitation of the National Anthem and Pledge. Students will take the pledge with the right fist placed over the heart.
- All students must sing the school anthem with pride and respect
- Students are to come to the assembly ground with the Revised Standard Version Bible and an updated Songs of Praise hymn book with the Open Heaven (Teen) manual

GENERAL CONDUCT

- All students are expected to be caring, persevering, humble, respectful, cultured and forward-looking.
- All students are to make good use of platforms created for their development

FACILITIES

- Do leave the areas in school in a better condition and state of cleanliness after use
- Take good care of school properties and premises. Cost of replacement for vandalized items will be borne out by student(s) responsible for the damage.
- Maintain highest standards of cleanliness at all times in the school premises. Cleanliness includes the maintenance of the immediate surrounding areas.
- Food and all sweet drinks are to be consumed and litter disposed into the trash bins
- Mobile phones are not allowed on students during school opening hours.

CLASSROOM CONDUCT

- All students must be punctual for lessons. Attendance will be taken before the start of each lesson
- Work with your classmates and teachers to achieve optimal outcomes.
- Keep a serene atmosphere always during lesson hours.
 Noise making and other kinds of distractions are prohibited.
- Students must not leave the classroom without permission by teachers.

- All students are expected to have the required writing and learning materials as borrowing from classmates is not allowed. Roaming around during lesson hours is equally prohibited.
- Consumption of food and sweet drinks are strictly prohibited in the classroom
- Maintain a conducive environment for teaching and learning
- Keep the classroom clean and neat at all times
- Update and check the class notice boards regularly
- Use of all forms of electronic gadgets is prohibited unless they are required for lessons e.g., calculators for mathematics and electronic dictionaries.

PERSONAL GROOMING SCHOOL UNIFORM IN GENERAL

The school supplies the following types of uniform:

 Classroom wear 	2 sets
ii. Sport wear	1 set
iii. Track suit	1 set
iv. School shoe	2 pairs
v. School cardigan	1
vi. House wear	1

- Students must wear the prescribed school uniform and any modification is strictly not allowed except to alter the length of the skirts and pants
- Students are to wear black school shoes and predominantly black track shoes. Black socks for both male and female students or recommended socks with the school tie must be worn and visible at all times.
- Students must wear the prescribed school uniform and any modification is strictly not allowed except to alter the length of the skirts and pants
- Student are to wear black school shoes and predominantly black track shoes. Black socks for both male and female students or recommended socks with the school tie must be worn and visible at all times.
- If for any reason, a student cannot wear shoes (such as bruises or injuries), the class teacher must be informed with the support of parent's letter.

For boys

Tapering of pants is strictly not allowed.
 The pant may be altered to the appropriate length only

For girls

- Skirts must be purchased from the school. They should be at knee length, i.e., touching the knee caps
- Sports wears may only be worn during sports training or P.E lessons

Hair

- Hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times
- Fancy hair styling, tinting, dyeing, highlighting and bleaching of hair are strictly not allowed for all students

For Boys

- Male student must be neat in appearance and clean-shaven at all times. No facial hair is allowed
- Hair must not touch the collar and must be sloped at the sides and rears. No side burns and ducktails are allowed.
- Hair must not be permed

For Girls


- Female student must be neat in appearance at all times.
- Hairdos are allowed for female students but must be in accordance with school procedures. Styles in haircuts are not allowed equally.

OUR SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATION

- You must be punctual. All students are expected to be in school on or before 7:30am
- 2. Be neat and corporate in the official school uniform at all school gatherings always
- Students must speak English language at all times except during Yoruba and French lessons
- All students must take proper care of school properties: desks, chairs, board, etc. in their respective classes
- 5. Eating is not allowed while lesson is in progress
- 6. The school is intolerable with noise making. Hence, all students must observe absolute decorum during lesson hours
- Moving around with the uniform after school hours is not allowed. If caught, the penalty is suspension for a day.
- 8. No students is allowed to use a cell phone in the school
- 9. Any student caught in the act of malpractice (test or examinations) shall have him/her name penned down in the black book (book for offenders) and be made to repeat the academisc session as ultimate punishment.
- 10. Respect must be given to your teachers and senior colleagues always
- 11. No students should engage and fighting, stealing, cheating, or any immoral act capable of tarnishing the good image of the school
- 12. No students is allowed to play any object like football, can etc. in any classroom or anywhere in the compound except places designated for such and at the right time.
- 13. No students should go out with any visitor during and after the school hours without the permission of the principal or teachers.
- 14. Students are not allowed to use vulgar languages and curses in school
- All students must participate in fasting and prayer on Fridays except for health issues
- Students should be well-behaved within and outside the school premises as you are the ambassadors of the school.
- 17. No student should urinate or defecate in any part of the compound except designated places for such.
- All students are expected to have personal writing materials as borrowing from a colleague is prohibited.

PLEDGE


This is to certify that I have read and understood the rules and regulation of the school, and I hereby promise to keep and obey them. I shall with all my strength to make the school better than I met it.

OFFENCES AND PUNISHMENT

- Lateness to school flogging/sweeping of school environment, weeding for first period
- **Dirtiness/Improper dressing** flogging and a day suspension/ uniform will be washed right in the school by the student.
- Vernacular speaking two strokes of cane
- Vandalism -student will replace damaged properties
- Noise making as decided by the teacher in charge
- Hawking/roaming /wandering/loittering around town while on school uniform a week suspension
- Using of electronic gadgets (mobile phones)during school hours total seizure of such gadgets
- Cheating during test/examination automatic repition of the class
- Rudeness to staff (teaching and non-teaching)suspension for a week with apology letter upon resumption
- Physical assault/abuse (fighting, bullying, foul languages etc.) on a fellow student-flogging on the assembly and a week suspension
- Playing football in the classroom seizure of objects and flogging
- Improper haircut or hairdo sent back home for proper haircut/hairdo
- Truancy invitation of parents initially and automatic withdrawal after bearable considerations
- Fighting on school uniform outside the school automatic withdrawal
- Eating on uniform while walking to and fro the school punishment within the school and a week suspension may be applied if practice continues
- Stealing suspension from classroom activities for a week
- Sexual immoralities/assaults compulsory counselling in a week; two weeks suspension and letter of undertaking from ward/parent.
- Bringing of contraband materials to the school such as alcohol, sharp objects, romantic novels, mirror, hair brush, cosmetics etc. - seizure of items and a week suspension.

OBLIGATIONS

Every student is obligated to achieve excellence in academics, morals and character that will make his or her parents, the country, the society at large and even God to be proud of him or her. This is the expectation of the school from all students.
